- Performance Schedule:
 - Saturday August 29: 1:15 pm to 6:15 pm: studio and outdoor performing events
 - Saturday August 29: call for dancers at 6:00 pm at the Briggs Opera House (BOH); performance from 7pm to 9pm
- TJDF will make an effort to schedule you to the venue you chose but we CANNOT GUARANTEE that your piece will be shown at the Brigg's Opera House as performance time there is limited to two hours. Note that preference at the Briggs Opera House performance will go to groups of dancers. When you return the signed form above, you will have agreed to perform your piece in the venues and at the time TJDF has assigned to you.

Please be aware that there are no set tech or dress rehearsals for studio and outdoor showings, but you may take sometimes prior to your performance for a run through.

- If your piece is assigned to the performance in Brigg's Opera House, you and ALL your dancers agree to attend all tech and dress rehearsals, as well as the performance. **You will not be able to perform at the Briggs Opera House if you fail to show up for BOTH the tech and dress rehearsals.**
 - The tech rehearsal will take place on **Friday, August 28 from 6-9pm.**
 - You will be provided with a schedule of appearance for the tech rehearsal once all registrations are in.
 - The dress rehearsal is **Saturday, August 29 from 10:15am to 12:15pm.**
You and ALL your dancers agree to arrive prepared and on time.
- All dances/pieces MUST not be more than 7 minutes. Please consider the attention span of the audience. Solos are strongly encouraged to be 3 minutes or less.
- Tech is minimal: lights are ramped up/down or on/off. You may request a color scheme. Music is on and off and should be engineered in advance and recorded on ONE TRACK and EMAILED upon request. If you have props, they must be small or easy to move quickly (there is no storage space at BOH for props).
- This is a family event. No overtly violent or mature content is allowed--no nudity, foul language, offensive lyrics or swears in your piece.
- You agree to submit your program information, bio, and music by the dates requested by TJDF. These dates will be sent in follow up material once your piece is accepted. Please submit the information in the format requested.
- You agree to show respect for everyone involved in this festival (dancers, choreographers, organizers, volunteers, guests etc.).
- Each choreographer (or dance group) is allowed ONLY one piece to be performed at the Briggs Opera House. If you would like to present an additional piece you will have a choice to perform in a studio or outdoors.
- You and your participants will NOT hold TJDF, The Briggs Opera House, or any staff liable for injury, theft or loss incurred on the premises. You will be asked to sign a liability waiver upon acceptance in the festival.
- NO TAP SHOES or other footwear that could damage the floor at the Brigg's Opera House or in the studios.
- You agree to confirm receipt of information provided to you by TJDF upon request.
- NO VIDEOTAPING during the performance at the Brigg's Opera House. The performance will be videotaped by a professional and will be made available to artists for a fee. However videotaping will be allowed during the dress rehearsal.
